

Champion of Champions (C of C)

1. This tournament runs concurrently with the Summer Sweeps (July), usually at Mt Si Golf Course.
2. To qualify, the entrant has to have won a gross championship (Match play or Scratch) according to USGA Rules, anywhere, at anytime. She has usually won her own club championship.
3. Each entrant pays an extra \$10.00 to enter, and that is the entire prize fund for the C of C. This competition is self supporting.
4. The Treasurer sends out the money to winners after the tournament.
5. When a player signs up for this tournament, she needs to indicate how she qualifies. Call the City Representative if she doesn't, because entrants sometimes get mixed up about the requirements and she may not actually qualify.
6. There are usually around 20 players and three flights. (See last year's large flight sheets)
7. Setup
 - Make a separate list of ladies playing in the C of C.
 - Put a red (or whatever color you like) dot on the scorecards of the C of C players. (see last year's scorecards)
 - Hand write the long flight sheets with each person's name, handicap and how they qualify - for each flight.
 - Post these sheets at Mt Si during the tournament and ask a couple of Mt Si ladies to write the scores on the flight sheets for each of the C of C players at the end of play. (They have done this for years and are very helpful.)
 - They turn in their cards to a separate basket at the end of play.
 - When all scores are in, you indicate who is the Champion (Low Gross) and also flight winners on the sheets.
 - Announce the winners. (hopefully you will have a microphone)
