TEAM CAPTAIN'S RESPONSIBILITIES

1. Team Captains are required to attend or be represented by proxy at the Annual February meeting.
2. To your home club's team:
 - a. Inform members at the beginning of the season the eligibility requirements to participate in team. (See Standing Rules: Paragraph "A", page 1 and Paragraph "J", pages 7 – 8)
 - b. ***Stress the importance of each team member knowing the USGA Rules of Golf, PACE OF PLAY rules 5.6a & 5.6b. Particularly those rules that pertain to 4-Ball Match Play.***
 - c. Go over the GSWPGA "Standing Rules on Team Play" (Paragraph "J" pages 7 – 8) Refer to the USGA Rules of Golf 2019 rule 3.2, pages 23 – 24
 - d. ***Instruct your team members on how to score (GSWPGA) 4-Ball Match Play. (See attached Team Competition Scoring Sheets)***
 - e. Impress on the entire team they should arrive at the course ½ hour before your team's first bracket tee time.
 - f. Ask your players to turn in their team results to you IMMEDIATELY following the completion of their match. (Assist them if they need help or have ruling questions)
 - g. IT IS YOUR RESPONSIBILITY TO MAKE SURE YOUR PLAYERS POST THEIR SCORES AT THE HOST COURSE COMPUTER THAT DAY!!!! The GHIN system has changed and updates daily.
3. When you host a match at your course: ***Captains please provide a course Marshall or expediter.*** Please provide a starter if needed. Provide printed local rules for each foursome if there are any unique rules or conditions.
4. It is your responsibility to fill out the Match Results sheets **CORRECTLY** and have the opposing Team Captain attest by signing. Then turn into the City Team Captain - Angela Hobbs or designate.
